Programs, Outreach and Education

The AKTCA -

- Collaborates with the Alaska State Therapeutic Court to provide Peer Support Groups and activities for court participants in Anchorage, Bethel, Fairbanks, Juneau, Kenai, and Palmer.
 - In Anchorage we partner with Volunteers of America to offer a monthly presentation, Victims Impact Panel, for court ordered first time DUI offenders.
 - In Fairbanks we offer a presentation, Reality Check, for second time DUI Offenders.
- Provides trained facilitators for weekly Therapeutic Court Peer Support Groups in Anchorage, Juneau, Kenai and Palmer.
- Communicates with Alaska local, state and national legislators to raise awareness, and understanding of the benefits of therapeutic courts, treatment, and to destigmatize recovery.
